Section 8-13-1308, S.C. Code Ann., 1976, as amended, requires candidates to file Campaign Disclosures within ten (10) days of receiving or expending \$500; fifteen (15) days prior to each election; within ten (10) days of the end of each quarter; and a final report when the campaign account is closed. In addition, certified campaign reports detailing campaign contributions and expenditures must contain the total of contributions accepted, the name and address of each person making a contribution, the total expenditures made by or on behalf of the candidate or committee, and the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made from campaign funds. Pursuant to Section 8-13-1362 and Regulation 52-504 (C), the Pre-Election and quarterly report are required even when there have been no contributions or expenditures.

Records of the State Ethics Commission indicate that a Campaign Disclosure was due no later than January 10, 2020, April 10, 2020, July 10, 2020, October 10, 2020, January 10, 2021, April 10, 2021, July 10, 2021, and October 10, 2021. Respondent was sent an email reminder thirty days before each Campaign Disclosure deadline.

Respondent was reminded of the filing requirements by a certified letter dated August 16, 2021 as described in the attached. To date, no properly completed January 10, 2020, April 10, 2020, July 10, 2020, October 10, 2020, January 10, 2021, April 10, 2021, July 10, 2021, or October 10, 2021 Campaign Disclosure has been received. All in violation of Section 8-13-1308(B) and Section 8-13-1308 (F), S.C. Code Ann., 1976, as amended.

All investigations, inquiries, hearings, and accompanying documents must remain confidential unless respondent waives the right to confidentiality. If there is a finding of probable cause, the following documents become public record: the complaint, the response (if any) by respondent, and the notice of hearing. If a hearing is to be held, the final order and all exhibits become public record. If no hearing is held following a finding of probable cause, the final disposition of the matter becomes public record. The willful release of confidential information is a misdemeanor, and any person releasing such confidential information, upon conviction, must be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisoned not more than one year. Section 8-13-320(10)(g).

BEFORE THE STATE ETHICS COMMISSION

CONSENT ORDER

This matter comes before the State Ethics Commission (Commission) by way of a Complaint filed on November 24, 2021. Pursuant to Section 8-13-320(10)(i) of the South Carolina Ethics, Government Accountability, and Campaign Reform Act (Ethics Act), the Complaint against Angele White-Bradley (Respondent) was considered by the Commission and probable cause was found to warrant an evidentiary hearing. Prior to the call of the case, Respondent agreed to the following:

STATEMENTS OF FACT

1. Respondent has served on the Lamar City Council (Council) since 2015. Respondent was re-elected on November 5, 2019 and November 7, 2023.
2. On January 27, 2021, Respondent filed a 2019 Pre-Election Campaign Disclosure Report (CDR), disclosing \$200.00 in on-hand contributions.¹ Respondent failed to file additional CDRs thereafter.
3. In an August 16, 2021 certified letter, the Commission notified Respondent of her failure to timely file CDRs for the following quarters: January 10, 2020; April 10, 2020; July 10, 2020; October 10, 2020; January 10, 2021; April 10, 2021; and July 10, 2021.
4. According to the United States Postal Service, the certified letter was delivered to Respondent's address of record on August 19, 2021 at 11:44 a.m. The return receipt does not appear to contain Respondent's signature; rather, it reads "MCS R82 C-19."
5. Following the filing of the Complaint, Respondent's campaign bank account records were

¹ This CDR was filed late and Respondent was assessed a \$100.00 late-filing penalty outside of this Complaint.

subpoenaed. According to these records, Respondent was required to file CDRs from January 10, 2020 through April 10, 2022.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the Statements of Fact, the Commission concludes, as a matter of law:

1. At all times relevant, Respondent was a “candidate” pursuant to Section 8-13-1300(4). Therefore, the Commission has personal and subject matter jurisdiction.
2. Section 8-13-1308(B) provides, in relevant part:

Following the filing of an initial certified campaign report, additional certified campaign reports must be filed within ten days following the end of each calendar quarter in which contributions are received or expenditures are made, whether before or after an election until the campaign account undergoes final disbursement pursuant to provisions of Section 8-13-1370.

3. Section 8-13-1510(A) provides, in relevant part:

. . . a person required to file a report or statement under this chapter who files a late statement or report . . . must be assessed a civil penalty as follows: (1) a fine of one hundred dollars if the statement or report is not filed within five days after the established deadline provided by law in this chapter; and (2) after notice has been given by certified or registered mail that a required statement or report has not been filed, a fine of ten dollars per calendar day for the first ten days after notice has been given, and one hundred dollars for each additional calendar day in which the required statement or report is not filed, not exceeding five thousand dollars.

4. Section 8-13-130 allows the Commission to “levy an enforcement or administrative fee on a person who is in violation” of the Ethics Act.

DISCUSSION

The Commission found probable cause to charge Respondent with ten (10) counts of violating Section 8-13-1308(B) for failing to file CDRs from January 10, 2020 through April 10, 2022.²

² The Commission also found probable cause to believe Respondent failed to disclose numerous contributions and expenditures in violation of Section 8-13-1308(F). Because Respondent has since disclosed these contributions and expenditures, the Commission declines to proceed on these charges.

Through this Consent Order, Respondent admits she violated the Ethics Act as described herein.

DISPOSITION

1. The Commission finds Respondent in violation of ten (10) counts of 8-13-1308(B).
2. The Commission adopts the Statements of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Discussion, and Disposition as agreed upon by the Respondent.

THEREFORE, the Commission hereby issues this Public Reprimand and orders Respondent to pay the Commission a late-filing penalty of \$1,000.00 (\$100.00 per report) and an administrative fee of \$300.00, for a total of \$1,300.00.³
