Section 8-13-1140, SC Code Ann., 1976, as amended, requires the filing of an updated Statement of Economic Interests for the previous calendar year annually thereafter prior to March 30. Records in the State Ethics Commission indicate that the Respondent was required to file the 2017 Statement of Economic Interests by March 30, 2017.

Section 8-13-1308, S.C. Code Ann., 1976, as amended, requires candidates to file Campaign Disclosures within ten (10) days of receiving or expending \$500; fifteen (15) days prior to each election; within ten (10) days of the end of each quarter; and a final report when the campaign account is closed. Records of the State Ethics Commission indicate that a quarterly Campaign Disclosure was due no later than January 10, 2017 and April 10, 2017. The Respondent was sent an email reminder thirty days before the quarterly Campaign Disclosure deadlines.

Section 8-13-1308 (F), S.C. Code Ann., 1976, as amended, requires that certified campaign reports detailing campaign contributions and expenditures must contain the total of contributions accepted, the name and address of each person making a contribution, the total expenditures made by or on behalf of the candidate or committee, and the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made from campaign funds.

Respondent was reminded of the filing requirement by letters sent January 17, 2017 and April 28, 2017 as described in the attached. To date, no properly completed 2017 Statement of Economic Interests, January 10, 2017 Campaign Disclosure, or April 10, 2017 Campaign Disclosure have been received. All in violation of Section 8-13-1140, Section 8-13-1308 (B), and Section 8-13-1308 (F), S.C. Code Ann., 1976, as amended.

All investigations, inquiries, hearings, and accompanying documents must remain confidential until final disposition of a matter unless the respondent waives the right to confidentiality. The willful release of confidential information is a misdemeanor, and any person releasing such confidential information, upon conviction, must be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisoned not more than one year. Section 8-13-320(10)(g).

10. In response to count One-Hundred Seventy-Two, Respondent denies the allegations set forth and alleges in response that neither she nor her campaign have any connection to the named entity.

FOR A SECOND DEFENSE

11. Respondent submits that all entries made were so made in good faith and in consultation with employees of the Ethics Commission. Given the unique nature of her single year election cycle, comprised of *six separate elections (two of which occurred on the same day)*, unique in South Carolina history and practice, her filings are and will remain utterly confused. Indeed, even members of the Ethics Commission have been unable to guide Respondent accurately in her filings.

12. Respondent gives notice of the intent to assert any further affirmative defenses that any investigation supports, including, but not limited to, defenses that the action is barred in whole or in part by any applicable statute, contract, release, covenant, or the doctrine of laches. Thus, Respondent reserves the right to amend this pleading to assert any such defenses.

13. Respondent requests a meeting with the General Counsel and the Director of the Commission to resolve these issues and bring this matter to a close.

WHEREFORE, having answered, Respondent asks this Commission to dismiss the allegations against her and to grant such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.

That Dalhi Myers, a member of the Richland County Council, did in Richland County, fail to maintain records for two campaign expenditures totaling \$649.38 for “Right of Setoff” made on August 5 and 23, 2016, in violation of 8-13-1302(A).

COUNT FORTY-SEVEN
FAILURE TO TIMELY DEPOSIT CONTRIBUTIONS INTO CAMPAIGN ACCOUNT
SECTION 8-13-1312, S.C. CODE ANN., 1976, AS AMENDED

That Dalhi Myers, a member of the Richland County Council, did in Richland County, fail to timely deposit a May 6, 2016 contribution from Jannie Jackson, a June 8, 2016 contribution from Kathryn Oken, and an October 6, 2016 contribution from the SC Builder’s PAC into her campaign account, in violation of 8-13-1312.

You have the right to be represented by counsel, the right to call and examine witnesses, the right to introduce exhibits, and the right to cross-examine opposing witnesses. This hearing will be open to the public as required by Section 8-13-320(10)(j), Code of Laws, South Carolina, 1976, as amended. The procedures to be followed are set forth in the Administrative Procedures Act, Section 1-23-10, et seq., Code of Laws, South Carolina, 1976 as amended the State Ethics Act, Section 8-13-100, et seq., Code of Laws, South Carolina, 1976, as amended, and State Ethics Commission Regulations, S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 52-707 (1997 Cum. Supp.).

A pre-hearing conference may be scheduled prior to the hearing to allow exchange of witness lists and evidence, marking of exhibits, and disposition of motions or pleadings. In the event you fail to appear, judgment by default will be rendered against you. 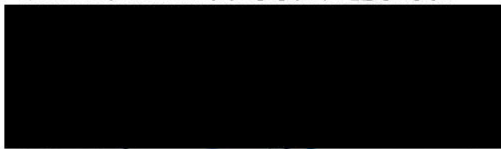

Respondent, Dahli Myers ("Respondent"), states that the properly named Respondent should be Dahli Myers, and answering Complainant's allegations, states the following:

FOR A FIRST DEFENSE

1. Each and every allegation set forth within the Notice of Hearing not specifically admitted herein is denied.
2. As to the allegations set forth in Count One, Respondent admits only so much as alleges that this action has been brought involving her filings related to six elections during the extraordinary 2016 cycle in which she appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day. Respondent denies the remaining allegations set forth in Count One.
3. As to the allegations set forth in in each and every enumerated Count, Respondent admits only so much as alleges that this action has been brought involving her filings related to six elections during the extraordinary 2016 cycle in which she appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day. Respondent denies the remaining allegations set forth in each allegation.

4. As to all allegations of Respondent's "Failure to Disclose Contribution on Campaign Disclosure Report," Respondent admits only so much of the Complaint as to make clear that her filings were made during the Summer and Fall of 2016, when appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day, in less than six months. Respondent alleges that while her campaign filings are confusing and admittedly incorrect in some places, that no one, including the Ethics Commission staff (with whom Respondent spent two full days attempting to decipher the proper filings), was able to intelligibly discern her appropriate filing schedule given the unique circumstances surrounding her unfairly compressed election cycles.

5. In response to all allegations of Respondent's "Failure to Disclose Expenditure on Campaign Disclosure Report," Respondent admits only so much of the Complaint as to make clear that her filings were made during the Summer and Fall of 2016, when appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day, in less than six months. Respondent alleges that while her campaign filings are confusing and admittedly incorrect in some places, that no one, including the Ethics Commission staff (with whom Respondent spent two full days attempting to decipher the proper filings), was able to intelligibly discern her appropriate filing schedule given the unique circumstances surrounding her unfairly compressed election cycles.

6. In response to all allegations of Respondent's "Failure to Deposit Campaign Contribution into Campaign Account," Respondent admits only so much of the Complaint as to make clear that her filings were made during the Summer and Fall of 2016, when she appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day, in less than six months. Respondent alleges that while her campaign filings are confusing and admittedly

incorrect in some places, that no one, including the Ethics Commission staff (with whom Respondent spent two full days attempting to decipher the proper filings), was able to intelligibly discern her appropriate filing schedule given the unique circumstances surrounding her unfairly compressed election cycles.

7. In response to all allegations One Hundred-Fifteen through One Hundred Thirty-Three, Failure to Pay Campaign Expenditure From Campaign Account” and/or “Failure to Sign A Campaign Check To Pay Campaign Expenditure,”, all of which relate to the expenditure of Respondent’s personal funds for campaign related expenses, Respondent admits only so much of the Complaint as to make clear that these erroneous filings were made at the direction of Ethics Commission Staff, following the Summer and Fall of 2016, when she appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day, in less than six months. Respondent alleges that while her campaign filings are confusing and admittedly incorrect in some places, that no one, including the Ethics Commission staff (with whom Respondent spent two full days attempting to decipher the proper filings), was able to intelligibly discern her appropriate filings and/or filing schedule given the unique circumstances surrounding her unfairly compressed election cycles.

8. As to the allegations of Respondent’s “Use of Campaign Funds For Personal Expense,” Counts One-Hundred Sixty-One through One-Hundred Seventy-One, Respondent admits only so much of the Complaint as to make clear that her filings were made during the Summer and Fall of 2016, when appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day, in less than six months. At no time did Respondent use campaign funds for personal expenses. Respondent alleges that while her campaign filings are confusing and admittedly incorrect in some places, that no one, including the staff of the Ethics Commission

staff (with whom Respondent spent two full days attempting to decipher the proper filings), was able to intelligibly discern her appropriate filing schedule given the unique circumstances surrounding her unfairly compressed election cycles.

9. As to all allegations of Respondent's "Failure to Deposit Contribution Into Campaign Account Within Ten Days of Receipt," Respondent admits only so much of the Complaint as to make clear that her filings were made during the Summer and Fall of 2016, when appeared on a ballot six times, on one occasion, appearing on two separate ballots on the same day, in less than six months. Respondent alleges that while her campaign filings are confusing and admittedly incorrect in some places, that no one, including the staff of the Ethics Commission staff (with whom Respondent spent two full days attempting to decipher the proper filings), was able to intelligibly discern her appropriate filing schedule given the unique circumstances surrounding her unfairly compressed election cycles.

10. In response to count One-Hundred Seventy-Two, Respondent denies the allegations set forth and alleges in response that neither she nor her campaign have any connection to the named entity.

FOR A SECOND DEFENSE

11. Respondent submits that all entries made were so made in good faith and in consultation with employees of the Ethics Commission. Given the unique nature of her single year election cycle, comprised of *six separate elections (two of which occurred on the same day)*, unique in South Carolina history and practice, her filings are and will remain utterly confused. Indeed, even members of the Ethics Commission have been unable to guide Respondent accurately in her filings.

12. Respondent gives notice of the intent to assert any further affirmative defenses that any investigation supports, including, but not limited to, defenses that the action is barred in whole or in part by any applicable statute, contract, release, covenant, or the doctrine of laches. Thus, Respondent reserves the right to amend this pleading to assert any such defenses.

13. Respondent requests a meeting with the General Counsel and the Director of the Commission to resolve these issues and bring this matter to a close.

WHEREFORE, having answered, Respondent asks this Commission to dismiss the allegations against her and to grant such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.

CONSENT ORDER

This matter comes before the State Ethics Commission (Commission) by way of a Complaint filed on June 2, 2017. Pursuant to Section 8-13-320(10)(i) of the South Carolina Ethics, Government Accountability, and Campaign Reform Act (Ethics Act), the Complaint against Dalhi Myers (Respondent) was considered by the Commission and probable cause was found to warrant an evidentiary hearing. The parties have chosen to resolve this matter by consent in lieu of a hearing, pursuant to the following terms.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In 2016, Respondent was a first-time candidate for Richland County Council (Council) in a special election.¹ In conjunction with the 2016 special election cycle, Respondent won the following elections: a May 31, 2016 special election primary; a June 14, 2016 special election primary run-off; and a July 19, 2016, special election general.
2. 2016 was also a general election year. In that regard, Respondent won the following elections: a June 14, 2016 primary election, a June 28, 2016 primary run-off election, and a November 8, 2016 general election.
3. Respondent was sworn into office on July 26, 2016.
4. Respondent filed several Campaign Disclosure Reports (CDR) in conjunction with her

2016 election cycles. Prior to the filing of the Complaint, Respondent's most recently-filed CDR was filed on December 2, 2016 and disclosed a negative balance of contributions in the amount of -\$23,406.50.

5. Respondent did not file a 2017 Statement of Economic Interests (SEI) on or before March 30, 2017.

6. In an April 28, 2017 certified letter mailed to Respondent's address of record, the Commission notified Respondent of her failure to file a 2017 SEI.² According to the United States Postal Service, the certified letter was delivered at 10:46 a.m. on April 29, 2017.

7. On May 2, 2017, Respondent contacted Commission staff and scheduled a May 12, 2017 appointment to receive assistance filing. However, Respondent did not appear for her appointment and did not contact the Commission to reschedule.

8. On June 2, 2017, the Complaint was filed.

9. Following the filing of the Complaint, a Commission Investigator contacted Respondent. Respondent advised that her mother's recent illness caused her failure to appear on May 12, 2017. Respondent also advised she was confused about her filings because of the numerous elections within a short timeframe.

10. On June 21, 2017, Respondent came to the Commission office and received assistance filing several reports, including the 2017 SEI.

11. During the Commission's investigation, Respondent's campaign bank account records were subpoenaed and reviewed, revealing numerous undisclosed contributions and expenditures,

² The Commission's April 28, 2017, certified letter also notified Respondent of her failure to timely file additional CDRs. However, these CDRs are not included in the current matter because they were filed prior to the filing of the Complaint.

as well as cash deposits and withdrawals. Additionally, many contributions and expenditures disclosed on Respondent's CDRs did not appear in the campaign bank account records. Respondent subsequently advised Commission Investigators that the contributions and expenditures disclosed on her CDRs but not reflected in her campaign bank account records were paid with personal funds rather than from the campaign bank account. As to the cash withdrawals, Respondent acknowledged using cash to pay campaign workers or to provide volunteers with food and drink during their volunteer activities. Respondent was unable to provide receipts or supporting documentation for the majority of her campaign expenditures.

12. On February 15, 2019, the Commission issued a Notice of Hearing, charging Respondent as follows: one (1) count of Section 8-13-1140 for failing to timely file a 2017 SEI; one-hundred and one (101) counts of Section 8-13-1308(F) for failing to disclose campaign contributions and expenditures; forty-two (42) counts of Section 8-13-1312 for failing to use a campaign bank account; eighteen (18) counts of Section 8-13-1302 for failing to maintain records associated with campaign expenditures; twelve (12) counts of Section 8-13-1348 for personal use of campaign funds; and four (4) counts of Section 8-13-1312 for failing to timely deposit campaign contributions. According to the Notice of Hearing, the matter was scheduled for May 16, 2019.

13. Respondent thereafter disclosed numerous contributions and expenditures listed within the Notice of Hearing. Respondent also paid \$700.00 to the Children's Trust Fund (CTF) in an attempt to rectify several of the personal expenditures made from her campaign bank account.

14. In light of Respondent's disclosures and payment to CTF, an Amended Notice of Hearing was issued containing: one (1) count of Section 8-13-1140 for failing to timely file a 2017 SEI; eleven (11) counts of Section 8-13-1308(F) for failing to disclose contributions and expenditures; thirty-one (31) counts of Section 8-13-1312 for failing to use a campaign bank account; three (3)

counts of Section 8-13-1302(A) for failing to maintain records associated with campaign expenditures; and one (1) count of Section 8-13-1312 for failing to timely deposit campaign contributions. According to the Amended Notice of Hearing, the matter was scheduled for January 16, 2020.

15. At the call of the January 16, 2020 hearing, Respondent appeared and requested a continuance. Respondent's request was granted, and the matter was continued until May 21, 2020.

16. On April 17, 2020, the Commission cancelled the May 21, 2020 hearing pursuant to Executive Order of the Governor restricting all non-essential meetings and activities due to the Covid-19 virus outbreak.

17. On October 1, 2020, the Commission issued a Second Amended Notice of Hearing scheduling the matter for December 17, 2020.

18. On December 7, 2020, Respondent's newly retained counsel requested a continuance, seeking additional time to prepare. The request was granted, and the matter was continued until February 18, 2021.

19. On December 17, 2020, Respondent was indicted by the State Grand Jury for the following: (1) Common Law Misconduct in Office; (2) Use of Official Position for Financial Gain; (3) Embezzlement; (4) Drawing and Uttering a Fraudulent Check, Value More than \$5,000; and (5) Use of Campaign Funds for Personal Expenses.

20. On January 7, 2021, counsel for Respondent filed a motion to hold the proceedings in abeyance pending the outcome of Respondent's criminal charges. The motion was granted, and the matter was removed from the Commission's February 18, 2021 docket.

21. On September 16, 2025, Respondent pled guilty to one (1) count of Misconduct in Office and three (3) counts of Use of Official Position for Financial Gain. Respondent subsequently paid \$6,416.56 in restitution to the County.

22. Throughout the course of these proceedings, Respondent has made numerous unsuccessful attempts to reconcile her campaign bank account records with her CDRs. As of the date of this Order, Respondent's last-filed CDR reflects a balance of \$1,188.94.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Commission concludes, as a matter of law:

1. At all times relevant, Respondent was a "candidate" pursuant to Section 8-13-1300(4) and a "public official" pursuant to Section 8-13-100(27).

2. Respondent was required to file SEIs with the Commission pursuant to Section 8-13-1110(B)(10).

3. Respondent failed to file a 2017 SEI on or before March 30, 2017, in violation of Section 8-13-1140, which provides, in relevant part:

A person required to file a statement of economic interests under this chapter annually shall file, pursuant to Section 8-13-365, an updated statement for the previous calendar year, no later than noon on March thirtieth of each calendar year.

4. Respondent failed to maintain records related to campaign expenditures pursuant to Section 8-13-1302, which provides, in relevant part:

A candidate [] must maintain and preserve an account of: the total amount of contributions accepted by the candidate...the name and address of each person making a contribution and the amount and date of receipt of each contribution; the total amount of expenditures made by or on behalf of the candidate...the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made including the date, amount, purpose, and beneficiary of the expenditure; all receipted bills, canceled checks, or other proof of payment for each

expenditure...The candidate must maintain and preserve all
receipted bills and accounts required by this article for four years.

5. Respondent failed to timely disclose campaign contributions and expenditures as outlined in the Second Amended Notice of Hearing, in violation of Section 8-13-1308(F), which provides, in relevant part:

Certified campaign reports detailing campaign contributions and expenditures must contain: (1) the total of contributions accepted by the candidate or committee; (2) the name and address of each person making a contribution of more than one hundred dollars and the amount and date of receipt of each contribution; (3) the total expenditures made by or on behalf of the candidate or committee; (4) the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure is made from campaign funds, including the date, amount, purpose, and beneficiary of the expenditure.

6. Respondent, as outlined in the Second Amended Notice of Hearing, failed to deposit campaign contributions into her campaign bank account within ten (10) days of receipt, and failed to make expenditures from the same, in violation of Section 8-13-1312, which provides, in relevant part:

Except as otherwise provided under Section 8-13-1348(C), expenses paid on behalf of a candidate or committee must be drawn from the campaign account and issued on a check signed by the candidate or a duly authorized officer of a committee. All contributions received by the candidate or committee, directly or indirectly, must be deposited in the campaign account by the candidate or committee within ten days after receipt.

7. Sections 8-13-130 and 8-13-320(10)(l)(i) allow the Commission to "levy an enforcement or administrative fee on a person who is in violation" of the Ethics Act, and to impose a civil penalty of up to \$2,000.00 for violations of the Act.

DISCUSSION

The Commission found probable cause to charge Respondent with various counts, enumerated above, related to receipt of campaign contributions, the expenditure of campaign funds, and recordkeeping and reporting requirements. Through this Consent Order, Respondent acknowledges she violated the Ethics Act when she failed to submit the required filings and disclosures, failed to maintain documentation and receipts of expenditures from her campaign bank account, failed to use a campaign bank account to deposit contributions and make expenditures, and withdrew cash from her campaign bank account.

In mitigation, Respondent asserts that because her election cycles occurred in succession at an abnormally rapid pace, documenting campaign activity and maintaining the records related to the appropriate election cycle and by the proper dates was difficult. Respondent also asserts that she was unfamiliar with the campaign disclosure requirements generally, as these were her first elections. Respondent acknowledges the deficiencies in her filings, but stresses that she “ha[s] not misappropriated any donations.” Rather, she “provided the ‘loans’ to [her] campaign...but did not properly categorize them...as ‘candidate funds.’” Respondent further notes her willingness to “correct the errors from [her] 2016 ‘Summer of Elections,’” and states that she has since filed the necessary disclosures.

DISPOSITION


1. The Commission hereby finds Respondent in violation of Sections 8-13-1140, 1302, 1308, 1312, and 1348 as outlined in the Second Amended Notice of Hearing issued on October 1, 2020.
2. The Commission hereby adopts the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Discussion, and Disposition as agreed upon by the Respondent.

THEREFORE, the Commission hereby issues a Public Reprimand and orders the Respondent, within six (6) months from receipt of this Order, to contribute the remaining balance identified in her CDRs (\$1,188.94) to the CTF or another charitable 501(c)(3) organization and to provide proof of such payment to the Commission. Additionally, pursuant to Section 8-13-130, the Commission orders Respondent to pay the Commission, within six (6) months from her receipt of this Order, an administrative fee of \$1,700.00. The Commission declines to seek any additional penalties in this matter given the complex procedural history surrounding this case, including the resolution of Respondent's criminal charges. By executing this Consent Order, Respondent understands that she is not only admitting to violations of the Ethics Act, but also confessing to a judgment of \$2,888.94. In the event Respondent does not make full and timely payment as provided for in this Order, the Commission shall file a Judgment against Respondent in the Richland County Clerk of Court's Office. Upon said filing, the Clerk of Court shall enter this Order in the amount of \$2,888.94 (less any amount paid to the Commission or charitable entity after the date of execution) in its Judgment Rolls, without cost to the Commission.
